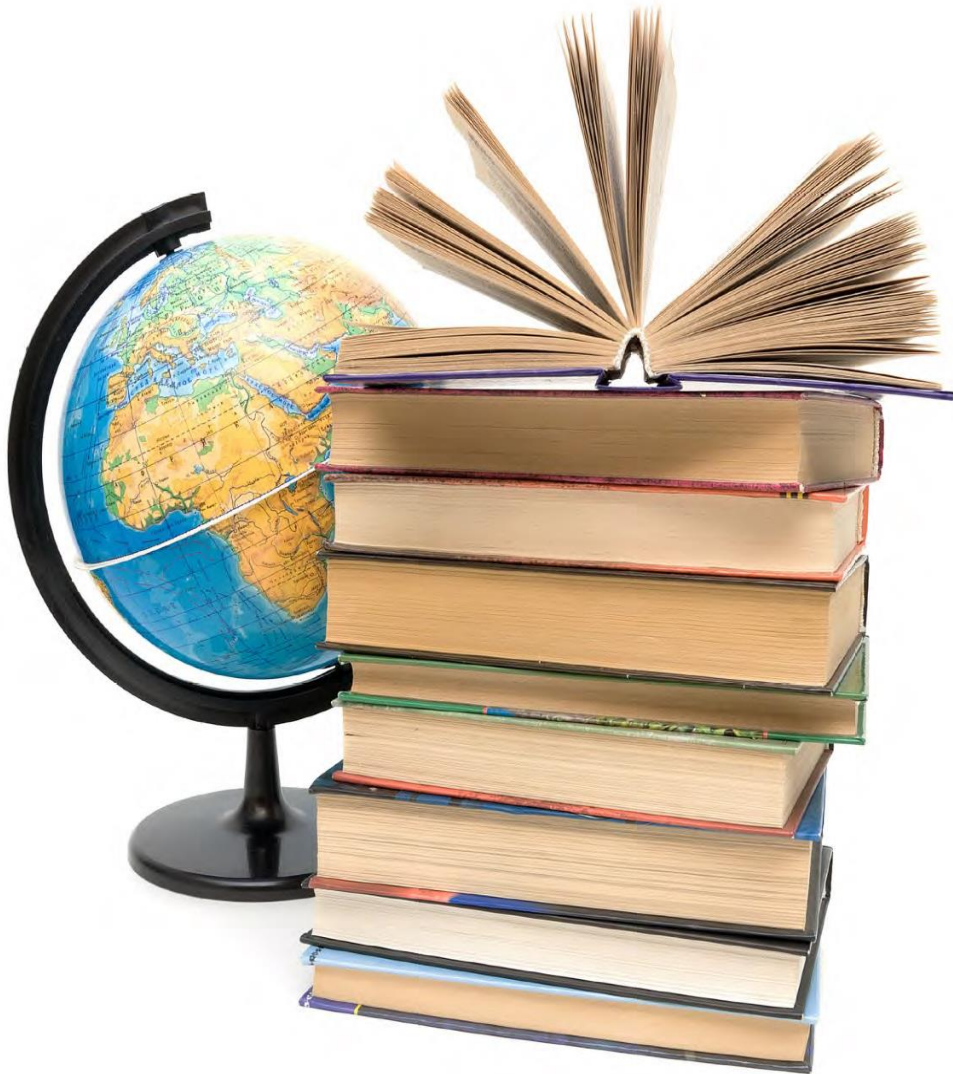

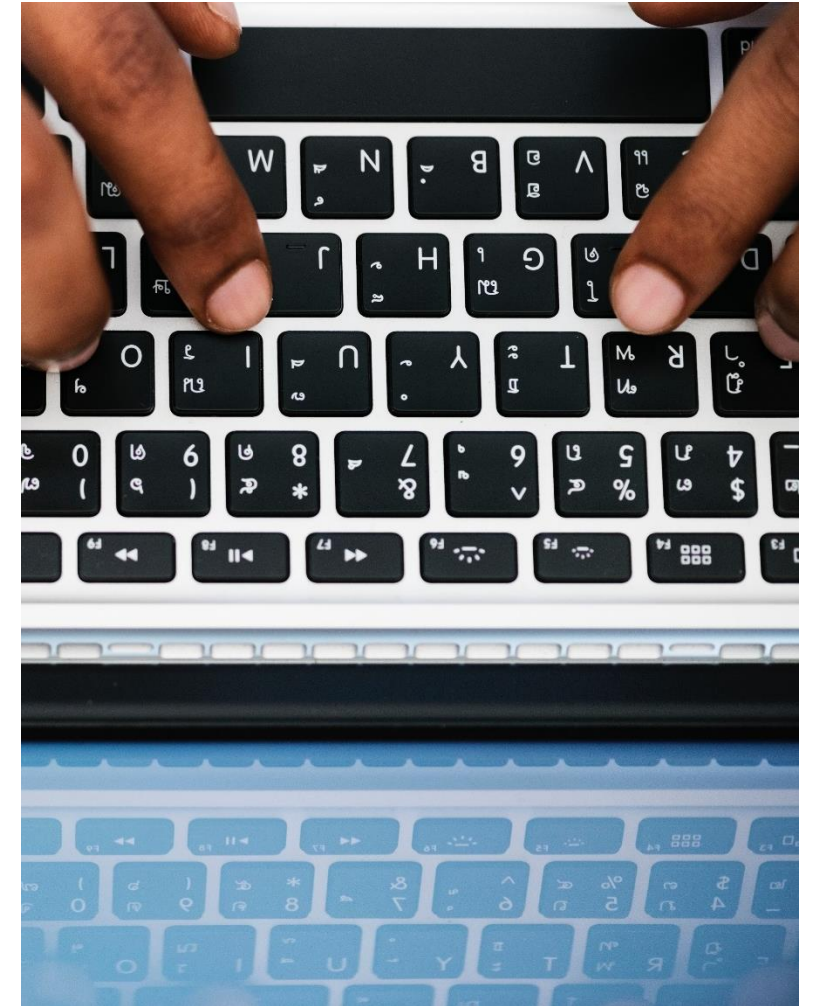

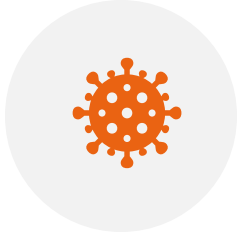

COVID Travel

- London – no proof of vaccination is required
- Dubai – no proof of vaccination required
- USA – mandatory proof of vaccination required (digital certificate)
- Brazil – mandatory proof of vaccination required (digital certificate)
- Argentina – no proof of vaccination required
- Mauritius – no proof of vaccination required
- SADC (Namibia/Botswana/SA) – no proof of vaccination required

Passports & Visas

- Passport must be valid for 6 months after date of return – check them now before booking your tour!
- Valid passports must have a minimum of 3 clear pages where 2 are opposite each other.
- Please check with me if you are not on a South African passport so I can advise accordingly.
- Visas are dependent on what passport you have as well as where you are travelling to.
- Visas take time – UK has a lead time of 2 weeks plus approval time of 5 working days.
- USA appointments only open from June so please go on and book as soon as possible – email me.

Breakaways

- Breakaways are when you extend your stay **after the tour has ended**.
- There are limited spaces per tour for breakaways and will be given on a first come first serve basis.
- There is a breakaway fee of R1500,00 min per person.
- Any extra travel services required for your breakaway can be done yourself or by me.
- Any extra visas you require should you need is for your own account.

Booking forms

- Please fill in the booking forms as soon as possible and send copies of passports etc.
- Please ensure you fill in your names as per passports i.e. first name, middle name, surname. No nick names or 2nd names as 1st names.
- Please specify your dietary requirements and send me an email if you need to discuss more i.e. strictly kosher or Halaal friendly vs strictly Halaal.
- Please adhere to the strict cut off times of booking and submitting booking forms as this affects final number confirmations etc.

Health & Insurance Requirements

- Yellow Fever – this is required for travel to Brazil.
- COVID - Travelers are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 if 2 weeks have passed since their 2nd dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.
- Personal travel insurance highly recommend for high value items. Basic cover provided by WBS.

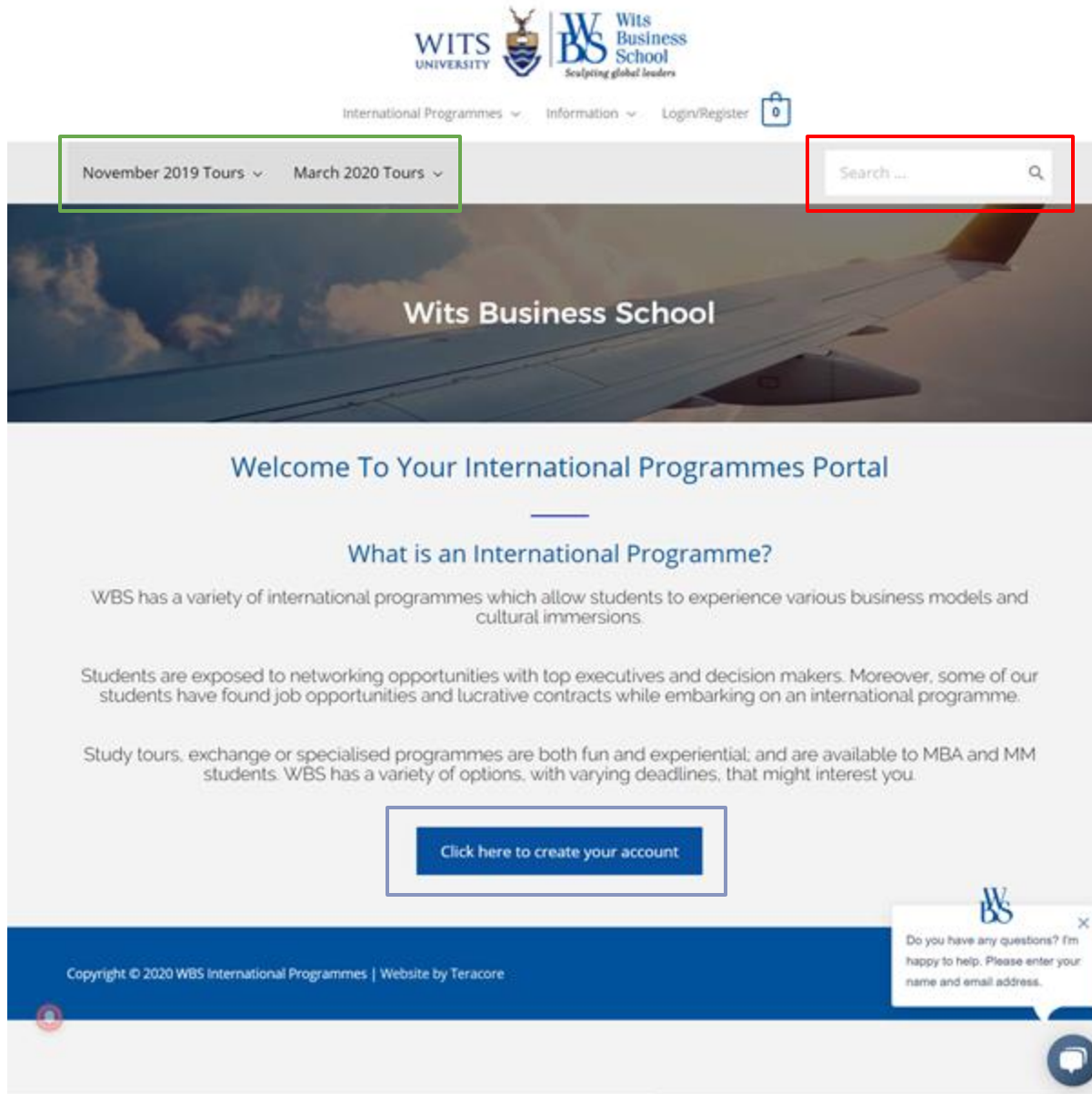

You will need to officially apply for a deferral through the WBS International Relations Department. Deferrals are taken into account with valid evidence such as a doctor's certificate. However, work commitments are not grounds for a deferral.

The cancellation will likely delay your graduation, as trips take place only twice a year.

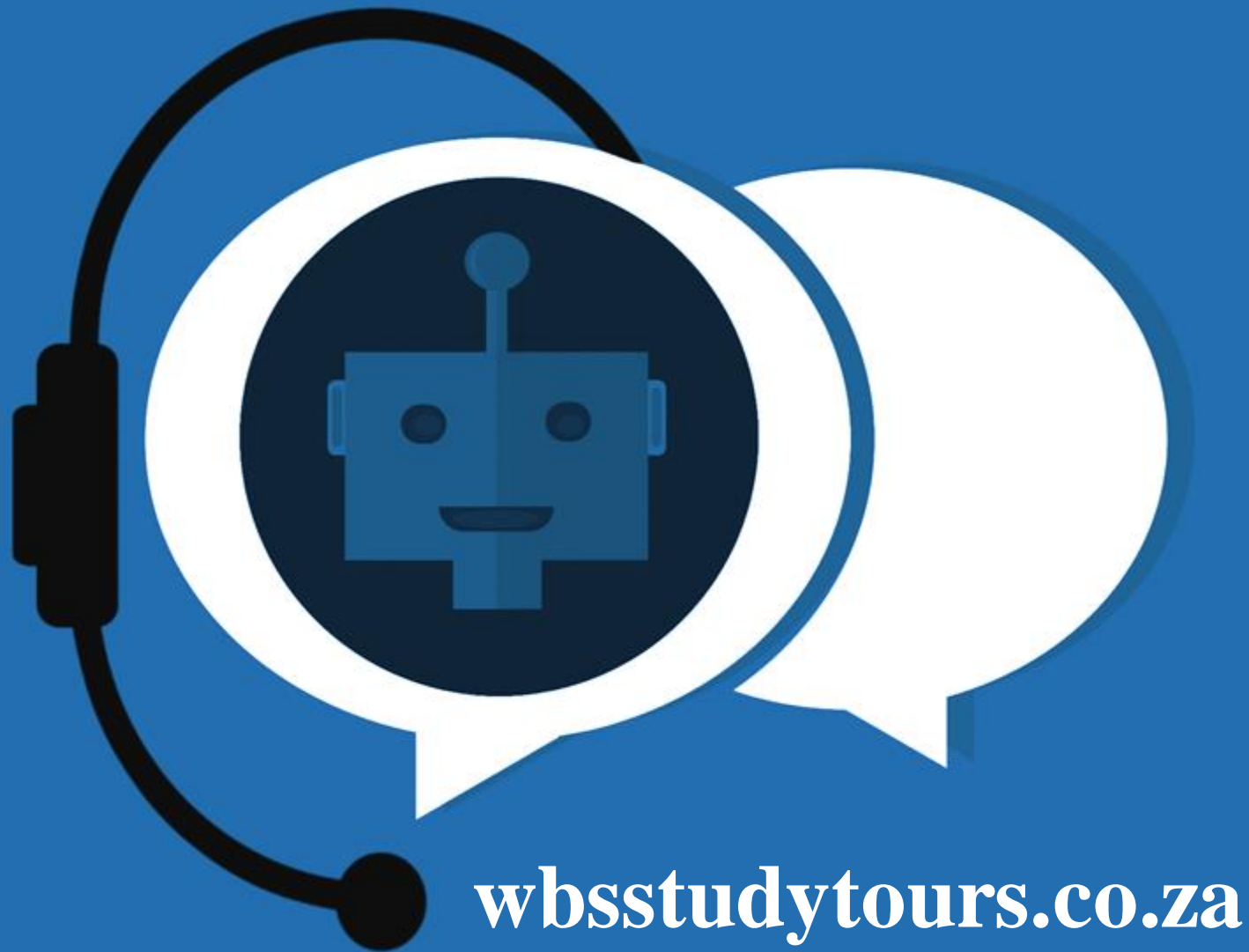
