What is the objective of your programme?




- Specialised programme: consisting of formal lectures which are intermediary and advanced.





Visas & Immigration

- All should have their USA visas by now, or be going for appointment soon.
- USA Arrival Immigration- they need to see all confirmations and vouchers and your passport etc. Same a US visa appointment, only give them what they ask for. Be presentable and polite. They can still deny you entry.
- Dubai Visas For those returning on 25 July, you could qualify for the Dubai Connect Stopover due to the length of the layover in Dubai 8hours 20min. Please send me a scan of a colour passport size photo and copy of US visa so I can apply for you.
- For those stopping over in Dubai, you can do your Dubai visas through the Emirates website.
- For those returning in August the layover is much shorter (4 hours) so no Dubai Visa/Dubai Connect is required.

Important Pre-Travel Reminders

- o **Boarding Pass:** While you can check in online, your boarding pass may only be available at the airport.
- Emirates Check-in/Bag Drop: Emirates check-in counters are located in Terminal B. Bag drop opens 4 hours before departure, 15:10. Please do not arrive later than 15:30.
- Vouchers: I will print your e-ticket as well as your hotel voucher as they will need to see them at USA immigration. Please print your insurance from WBS.
- Carry-on Restrictions: Ensure that no liquids, aerosols, or gels over 100ml per bottle are packed in your carry-on luggage. Larger items must go into your checked baggage.
- Luggage Allowance: You are allowed 2 checked bags (each at 23kg) and 1 carry-on (handbag/backpack + laptop, etc.), with a maximum weight of 7kg
- Bag Wrapping: You can wrap your bags at the airport for R100 per bag, but please note they only accept cash. However this is not recommended for travel to the US.

Insurance & Flight Info

- Personal travel insurance highly recommend for high value items. Basic cover provided by WBS.
- Please note that online check-in opens 48 hours before departure for your Emirates flights.
